The intensive care unit (ICU) management of patients with traumatic injuries presents a variety of challenges. Patients usually have been evaluated by an emergency clinician and/or a general or trauma surgeon prior to transfer to the ICU. However, patients remain at risk for deterioration due to unrecognized injuries, iatrogenic complications of initial diagnostic studies and therapy, and general complications of critical care.
